Grandpa is weaving! I want to try it too now.

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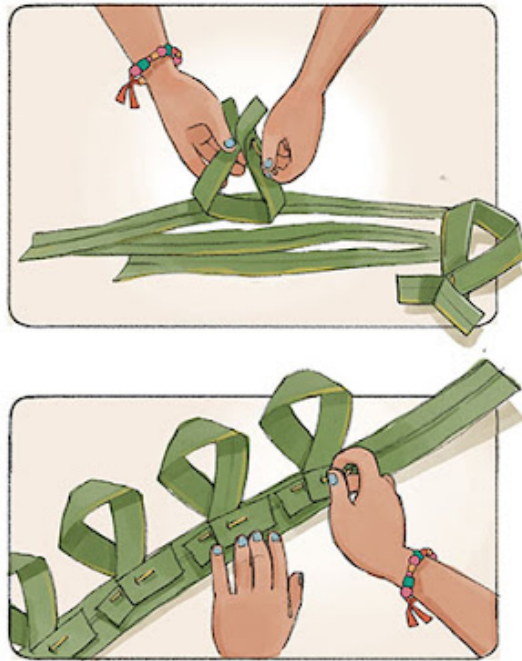
It is not easy. My hands can't do it yet.
